INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on your purchase of the Raven Smartboom system! This system is designed to provide worry-free turn on and turn off of your booms with respect to an as-applied area. The following instructions are designed to assist you in the proper installation of the Smartboom system. See the Operation Manual of your Smartboom console for instructions on setting up the software and using the Smartboom system.



Important! All boom switches must be in the OFF position and master switch must be in the ON position while Smartboom is in operation!

INSTALLATION

Use the following procedure to properly install the Smartboom system.

1. Locate the 12 pin armrest harness connector behind the armrest.




- 2. Disconnect and tee in the Smartboom harness.
- 3. Inspect the existing 12 pin armrest connector to determine if pin 12 is populated.
 - If not populated, locate the single packard connector on the armrest harness and tee in Smartboom harness. Master switch sense is now connected and installation is complete.
 - If populated, installation is complete (master switch sense is already connected internally to the Smartboom harness). Connect single packard connectors on Smartboom harness together to prevent contamination.

- 4. Connect the power leads to a good source of switched power.
